



Moffett Vineyards 2005 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

WINEMAKERS NOTES

Two great sources – St. Helena has both Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc; the Yountville vineyard has multiple clones of Cabernet that were blended together after 12 month in barrel.

The wine is dark as night when poured into the glass. The aromas are soft, but rich with blackberries, currants and a hint of mocha. On the palate, the wine delivers on many different levels. The fruit is rich and juicy with deep dark fruit flavors of Marion berries, black cherries and plum, as the fruit softens your palate starts to get the full character of the wine with its great balance of toasted oak and acidity. The finish is long, juicy and full of mouthwatering fruit.

PERFECT PAIRINGS

I had this wine the other night with chicken, wild rice with Portabella mushroom and a rich gravy, it was excellent.
