



Moffett Vineyards 2006 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2006 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon comes from two different vineyards in the Napa Valley. The first is a great little spot high up on Howell Mountain. This little 2 acre vineyard is located at 2100 feet and produces fabulous small cluster cabernet. The second vineyard is in St. Helena at one of the narrowest parts of the valley, this little spot is planted to both Cabernet and Cabernet Franc.

There's wonderful purity of flavors, richness and depth in this full-bodied red, with spicy currant, plum and wild berry, turning smooth and supple, polished and refined on the finish, where the flavors sail on. Drink now through 2017—James Laube 93 points Wine Spectator
