



Moffett Vineyards 2007 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2007 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignons core fruit comes from a magnificent little vineyard on Howell Mountain. This vineyard sits just over 2100 feet in elevation and is just shy of 2 acres in size. Being almost the highest vineyard in the appellation, it benefits from both the morning and afternoon sun. The second fruit source is from State Lane in Yountville. Here we get 4 rows out of a larger vineyard totaling approximately 3 tons of fruit. This vineyard is surrounded by mail list only high end producers and for good reason, this fruit is fabulous. The final little touch is from our St. Helena vineyard where we get a little Cabernet Franc, this rocky site produces some of the smallest berries we work with.

Aromas of wild berries fly out of the glass as you pour the wine, after further evaluations you start to notice the different layers of spice and well integrated oak. On the palate, this is a big rich wine with tremendous fruit, the balance of tannins and acidity are near perfect for great aging, but also allows you the ability to enjoy only minutes after opening. The fruit is seamless from start to finish
