WINE PROFILE

We have two excellent vineyards that help make up the Willow's Blend Red Wine. The first in a St. Helena vineyard that is planted to 3 acres of Cabernet Sauvignon and 1 acre of Cabernet Franc. The vineyard neighbors an old vineyard we worked with at Livingston Moffett that we named "rockpile" for its extreme soil. This is arguably the rockiest vineyard in the Napa Valley and provides us with concentrated stressed out fruit. The second vineyard is my Syrah vineyard in the Oak Knoll District. This practically dry farmed vineyard gives us (naturally) very low yields with dark as night fruit and wonderful Syrah characteristics.
